Page 10: Tours of **Detton Hall Farm** are no longer available due to recent change of ownership.

Page 16: Further detail is now available on the Burwarton Road/Brown Clee route: Follow the permissive pathway (old rail bed) to Burwarton Road. Walk left down this rural lane to where the road forks. Take the right fork and then left at the next fork to follow the road out onto the Burwarton Road (B4364). To obtain a walks guide (30p) to the area proceed right to the **Burwarton Estate Office** (open during business hours). For good food and pathways beyond proceed left to the highly acclaimed **Boyne Arms** (around the road bend). Walk distance from the SEW: 2km.

Page 19: Unfortunately both **The New Inn** and the **Oreton Post Office** have closed since the publication of this Guide.

Page 19: At **Little Stocking** the brick kiln, one of the oldest in the countryside, has recently (Nov 2006) been rebuilt. If you are interested in a site visit, please contact Ann or Trevor Sutton (01746 718266) in order to arrange access.

Page 21: At **Detton Hall Farm** the finger post illustrated (*View across ancient trackway*) has been removed.
